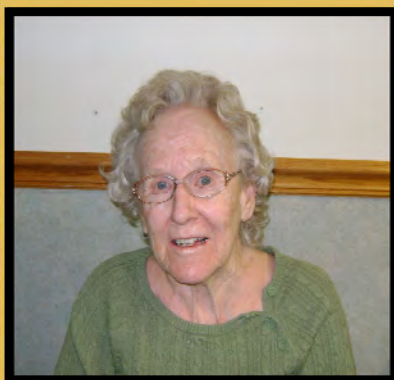

Lucille Denise (Nunny) Tysdal was born December 6, 1929 to James and Ethel Simons on the family farm near Plainview, South Dakota. Nunny was the second born of six children. Raised a child of the 1930's, Nunny developed the attitude of the eternal optimist, always looking for the good in everything that happened and always appreciative of the smallest gifts and possessions.

Nunny attended rural elementary school in the Plainview-Marcus, South Dakota area. She graduated from high school in Faith, South Dakota. During summer vacation, she would travel by train, and spend the time with an aunt and cousins in Chicago, working at a soda fountain across from Wrigley Field.

On April 22, 1949, Nunny married Clinton Tysdal. They lived on the Marks Ranch north of Redowl, South Dakota. Two years later, they moved to a ranch they purchased just west Redowl. They ranched in the Redowl (central Meade County) area for forty years. They were involved in the community in many ways including the Meade County Cowbells, South Dakota Stockgrowers, Grand River Electric Cooperative, and St. Anthony's Catholic Church. The ranch was sold in 1992 and they retired to Sturgis, South Dakota. They spent their winter in Wickenburg, Arizona for twenty-two years, where they met many friends from all over the country and Canada. Clinton passed away on September 12, 2006.

Nunny has two children, Wade of Johnson Lake, Nebraska, and Wendi of Kranzburg, South Dakota. She has five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. In recent years, Nunny has resided at Edgewood Vista in Spearfish, South Dakota and Stone Hearth Estates in Gothenburg, Nebraska. Nunny became part of the Elwood Care Center on March 20, 2013.
