June attended country school in Frontier County to 8th grade. June went to Idaho to help her sister's family after the birth of a baby. While there she met her brother-in-law's brother, Donald Easterday, a widower with two children. Donald and June were married April 4, 1953. June became mother to Gene, deceased and Carolyn Houser. To their marriage four children were born: Vernon of Eustis, John of San Francisco, CA, Rodney of Eustis and Marjorie Hueftle of Bartley.

In 1958 Donald and June moved to Nebraska to a farm south of Eustis. The family grew and all worked the family farm.
