Holiday Decorating Safety Tips

We encourage you to decorate your or your loved one's room for the holidays as you like. Our Fire Marshall has some guidelines for us to ensure everyone's safety:

- We must use Medical Grade extension cords only, please request one from a staff member
- Lights that are UL Listed are okay, we recommend "LED" lights as they stay cooler
- Small fiber optic trees are okay
- Any decoration placed on a resident's door that opens to a corridor must be flame retardant and made of artificial materials, fresh pine arrangements are beautiful, but the Fire Marshall says they are a hazard, sorry! No nails or tacks in doors, please use an over-the-door hook, tape, or 3M products.
